Background

New building energy performance standards went into effect in 2016 for state funded agencies and universities. These new rules (Texas Administrative Code 34 §19.32) mandate that state-funded buildings comply with the *ASHRAE 90.1-2013 Energy Standard for Buildings* or the *2015 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)*. The updated version of the standard is projected to achieve 8.5 percent in additional energy savings as compared to the 2010 standard.
