Atlanta, GA

ASHRAE and IBPSA-USA are convening this conference to improve the industry's ability to accurately model building performance. The conference merges the IBPSA-USA SimBuild and ASHRAE Energy Modeling Conferences. The focus is on making better decisions through the application of simulation and modeling over the entire building life cycle from the earliest concept through operation and maintenance. "This conference is a first for the industry, and we're excited about the benefits it can bring to the building energy analysis and performance simulation community," Dennis Knight, Conference chair, said. The conference seeks to improve the industry's ability to accurately model building performance. Modelers, software developers, owners and researchers will address the practices of energy modeling and building performance simulation using existing simulation tools, software development, and future simulation research and applications. The conference will take place at the Atlanta Marriott Buckhead.

Goals

The conference brings together the building energy analysis and performance simulation community for three days of discussion, seminars, and short courses. Modelers, software developers, owners, and researchers will address the practices of energy modeling and building performance simulation using existing simulation tools, software development, and future simulation research and applications. The conference will have a student component where students can submit a paper for a scholarship opportunity. More information will be posted.




