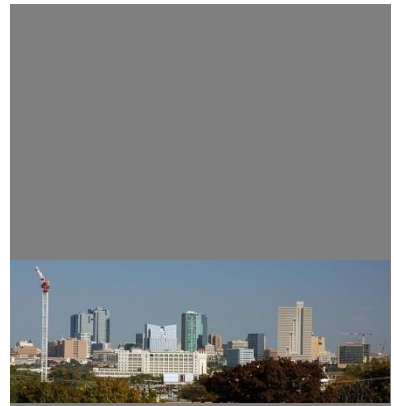

### IBPSA NORTH TEXAS CHAPTER TECHNICAL SESSION

March 17, Dallas, Texas (location TBD)

Nathan Kegel with Integrated Environmental Solutions will be presenting a technical session on energy modeling with floor multipliers. This is a presentation on a conference paper Nathan submitted for this year's [ASHRAE/IBPSA energy modeling conference](#).

Objectives include:

- Distinguish building types where grouping floors with thermally identical blocks will not impact energy modeling results.
- Model buildings accurately with an understanding of how climate impacts the use of floor multipliers.
- Understand that other factors such as different HVAC system types and external effects (like shading from adjacent objects) will have an impact on the accuracy of using floor multipliers in energy simulation.
- A demo of IES VE (the software tool used in the research paper) will also be given.
