5. Discuss Dropbox and how to gain access to it.

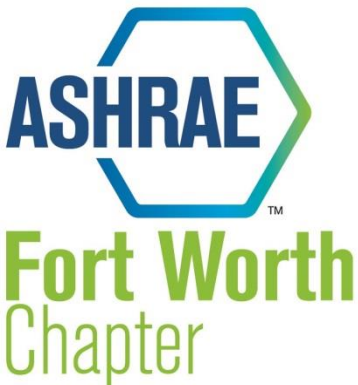
6. Goals for the year.
